Position

No Position 0

Summary: Adds employee or volunteer of organization providing child-related services or activities, employee of higher education institution, coach, assistant coach or trainer of child athlete and individual who provides guidance, instruction or training in youth development activity to list of public and private officials required to report child abuse. Requires school boards to adopt policies and take certain actions related to abuse of students by students. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Summary: Creates community guardianships as permanency planning option for ward in substitute care. Authorizes persons seeking appointment as community guardian to seek order for limited participation in juvenile dependency proceeding. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Summary: Transfers authority over court appointed special advocates and CASA Volunteer Programs from State Commission on Children and Families to Oregon Volunteers Commission for Voluntary Action and Service. Becomes operative on May 1, 2012. Prescribes duties and responsibilities of Oregon Volunteers Commission for Voluntary Action and Service. Requires commission to contract with and disburse moneys to CASA Volunteer Programs. Directs commission to present annual report to Legislative Assembly. Creates Court Appointed Special Advocate Fund and continuously appropriates moneys in fund to Housing and Community Services Department for Oregon Volunteers Commission for Voluntary Action and Service for purpose of providing court appointed special advocate services in state. Repeals provisions regarding CASA Volunteer Programs and court appointed special advocates on January 2, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Summary: Requires expungement of juvenile records for contact involving prostitution when subject was under 18 years of age at time of offense without waiting period and, if no objection is filed, without hearing. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Summary: Removes sunset on Early Learning Council. Establishes Early Learning Council Fund. Expands oversight of Early Learning Council. Establishes goals and timelines for Early Learning Council to complete specified projects. Changes name of Early Childhood System Director to Early Learning System Director. Establishes Youth Development Council to oversee unified system that provides services to children and youth in manner that supports academic success and reduces criminal involvement. Establishes goals and timelines for Youth Development Council to complete specified projects. Abolishes Juvenile Crime Prevention Advisory Committee. Transfers functions of committee to Youth Development Council. Abolishes State Commission on Children and Families. Transfers functions of commission to Early Learning Council and Youth Development Council. Abolishes local commissions on children and families. Abolishes Commission for Child Care. Transfers functions to Early Learning Council. Declares emergency, effective on passage.
